Inhalation, eye and face	Filter mask / protective goggles

Inhalation	Immediately take the victim to fresh air. For persistent symptoms, call in medical assistance.	
Eye contact	Immediately flush the eyes with copious water, and lift eyelids while doing so. Continue flushing for at least 15 minutes and call in medical assistance.	
Skin contact	Immediately wash skin with water and soap. For persistent symptoms, call in medical assistance.	
Swallowing	Consult a physician immediately. Do not induce vomiting and do not administer anything without explicit permission from a physician.	
Extinguishing products, storage, clearing and explosion safety		
Storage instructions	Store in a cool and well-ventilated place. Keep away from heat, open flames, sparks and other ignition sources.	
Clearing instructions	Collect any material released (avoid creating dust) and entrust it to the waste collection service. Do not discharge into the sewer or in surface water or groundwater.	
Extinguishing products	CO ₂ , foam, chemical powder for flammable liquids.	
Substance explosion class	Acetic acid can release vapours that are explosive in combination with air at temperatures exceeding 40 °C.
